Policy on Mobile Phones in School

The following is an outline of Scoil Ursula's procedure in relation to mobile phones.

- In general, pupils are **not** allowed to bring mobile phones to school.
- In certain circumstances, pupils from 4th class up may be allowed to bring a mobile phone at school.
- Any child bringing a mobile phone to school must have a written explanation from his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) seeking permission to do so.
- The child will give the written explanation and the phone (turned off) to the Class Teacher at the beginning of the day and ask for the phone back at the end of the day.
- Under no circumstances is a mobile phone to be used in the school or on the school grounds.
- If a child is found in possession of a mobile phone outside of the above arrangements, the phone will be kept in the office, until a parent/guardian comes to collect it and sign a release form (Overleaf).

Pupils who repeatedly bring phones to school without permission will have them confiscated as follows:

1st Offence: 1 Day

2nd Offence: 1 Week

3rd Offence: 1 Month

4th Offence: End of Term

5th Offence: End of School Year
